

Homemade Mandala Set

1. A set of round cookie cutters from a chef supplies shop, they come in a nice tin so you can use that as the base. You will get two mandala sets per box.
2. Or you can get colored plastic cookie cutters from a discount outlet, and then use a small round Tupperware container, or a mini aluminum pizza plate as the base. (Ideally about 2 cm tall and at least 15 cm across)
3. Decorate with stick-on diamantes, used for scrap booking
4. Use a shell, like a mini conch, for the top dharmachakra (from home decorator shops or aquarium supplies). Or sometimes party supplies shops have good gold plastic decorations.
5. For the 'rice', add in plastic jewels from aquarium supplies, or else glass jewels used to fill vases, so they don't tip over. Best is irregular shaped clear colored plastic beads, as these don't roll away!
